



DPS Chas Students **Excel** In **IIT**, Class **Xth** and Class **XII** Exam



Chas (Bokaro). Making their alma mater highly proud in very short span of 5 years, DPS Chas students have brought glory in excelling in IIT, Class X and class XII examination.

In IIT (JEE Advance) Yuvraj Kumar fetched 461 rank (category group) while Sreijan Sinha got 20420 rank. Earlier in the JEE Main examination, 25 percent of students who are appearing for this coveted engineering examination 26 percent students scored more than 90 percentile marks. Sreijan Sinha got 98.5 percentile, Harsh Kumar got 96 percentile, Hemant Kumar got 93 percentile while Yuvraj got 87 percentile marks, were among the successful students. Apart from this, about 6 students have scored more than 87 percent marks.

In class X CBSE final examination held in 2023, ADITI SHUBHAM topped the school fetching 97.8% marks. In AISSE examination, the ten toppers of the school are Mytakshara R S (96% marks), Golu Kumar (95.6%), Dhruv Prasad, Sourav Singh (95%), Sadique Quamar (94.8%), Mayank Raj (94.6%),

Raunak Raj (94%), Ananya Kumari (94%) and Binit Raj (94%).

In Class XII CBSE conducted final examination held in 2023 YUVRAJ KUMAR topped the list with 93.6 percent marks. In AISSEE the ten toppers of the school are Sagar Raj (92 % marks), Rishav Raj Kumar (91.6% marks), Abhivyakti Rajan (91.2% marks) and Aastha Pathak (91% marks).

The subject toppers are Aastha Pathak secured 98 in English, Abhivyakti Ranjan got 98 in PHE, while Aastha Pathak, Khushi Sandilya and Archana Tewary secured 97 marks each in HVM. Yuvraj Kumar got 95 each in Physics and Chemistry, on the other hand Hemant Kumar secured 94 in Mathematics. Congratulating the students and teachers Dr. Hemlata S. Mohan, the Chief Mentor of DPS Chas expressed her happiness saying that the result is the outcome of untiring efforts, perseverance and dedication of the team DPS Chas. Congratulating the students, Officiating Principal Deepali Bhuskute wished the students a bright future.

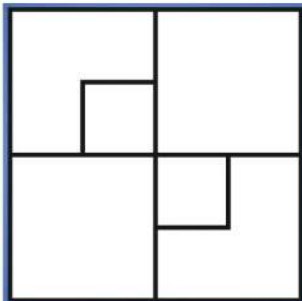
